- _____ You understand that food, kennels, litter, miscellaneous items, and all medical expenses are provided by Randolph County Humane Society. If you choose to buy any of the needed items without approval from Laurie Lesperance you are responsible for the bill(s).
- _____ You understand if your pet needs medical attention you MUST contact Laurie Lesperance at (618) 443-3363 or Sue Falkenheim at (618) 967-6043 immediately.
- _____ You understand that Randolph County Humane Society only deals with selected veterinarian clinics. You will be given the clinic phone numbers at the time of animal pick-up.
- _____ You understand that you cannot call and set up any vet appointments for your fostered animal. You must contact Laurie or Sue to set up any appointments.

- _____ You agree to abide by all applicable state, county, and municipal laws applicable to animals and their care.
- _____ You understand that Randolph County Humane Society has the right to terminate your fostering agreement at any time with out your approval.
- _____ You agree to provide humane care, proper socialization, and a loving environment to each and every one of your fostered pets.
- _____ You understand that you are dealing with a sheltered animal that is not housebroken, trained, and may have behavioral issues.
- _____ You understand that there may be a great deal of household destruction, accidents, and/or incidents that will involve your foster animal.
- _____ You agree not to hold Randolph County Humane Society responsible for any damages to your home, furniture, or for any accidents or incidents that may occur while you are fostering an animal for Randolph County Humane Society. This includes but not limited to bites, scratches, hospital or doctors visits, etc.
- _____ You understand that Randolph County Humane Society reserves the right to turn down any foster applications.
